Annual Management Fee: The monthly charge rate is directly related to the rolling two-year return of the Fund compared with that of its benchmark. The limits are 0.57-1.71% p.a. (incl. VAT). Should the Fund produce a return of 0% or worse over a 2-year rolling period, then the firm will forego all fees.

The Fund returned 18.1% for the year compared to the benchmark return of 6.2%. The returns were assisted by strong returns from the Fund's equity investments and the impact of a weaker Rand on the foreign component of the Fund. The Fund maintains a low net share exposure given the aims of the Fund and the relatively high level of equity markets. While we believe that future return expectations from the equity market should be tempered and that they are unlikely to give as much assistance to overall returns as they have done in recent years, we nonetheless continue to find investments that should generate attractive long-term returns for our investors. In recent months we introduced a hedged equity component to the Fund. This portion of the Fund provides an "interest-like" return plus or minus the extent to which the Fund's shares out or underperform the index. We believe that in the current environment this asset class is particularly attractive and is consistent with the Fund's objective of seeking real returns with a high level of capital stability. The Fund continues to maintain its high offshore exposure as we continue to believe that the Rand will have a negative bias until South Africa's current account deficit returns to more normal levels.


