Commentary

A year ago, we mentioned that several of your Fund's large positions were in companies with a domestic focus, at a time when many investors were bearish on the domestic Japanese economy. As always, this positioning was driven by our research on individual companies - at the time, we simply found more attractive opportunities among domestic shares than among exporters. Since then, many exporters have underperformed, making them cheaper relative to our assessment of their intrinsic value. As these companies have become more attractive, we have initiated positions in a few of them, including Toyota Motor, which is now a top ten holding. So while we continue to have confidence in your Fund's select domestic shares, its exposure to exporters has increased. Moving forward, all ideas will continue to compete for scarce capital, and your Fund will invest in those shares where the balance of risk and reward is most favourable.




