Commentary

The European bank stress tests, while imperfect, did provide markets with a degree of clarity. Still, your Fund remains underweight in banks, owing to our company-by-company fundamental analysis. Our investment process relies on a matrix of analyst teams: national research teams search for attractive stocks by region, as our global industry team searches by sector. Working independently, each team distils their research into a handful of their best ideas. When a national analyst and a global industry analyst independently recommend a stock, investment conviction can be higher. Currently, our disciplined research process finds only four banks attractive enough for investment, including the recent addition of Spain's Banco Bilbao Vizcaya Argentaria.

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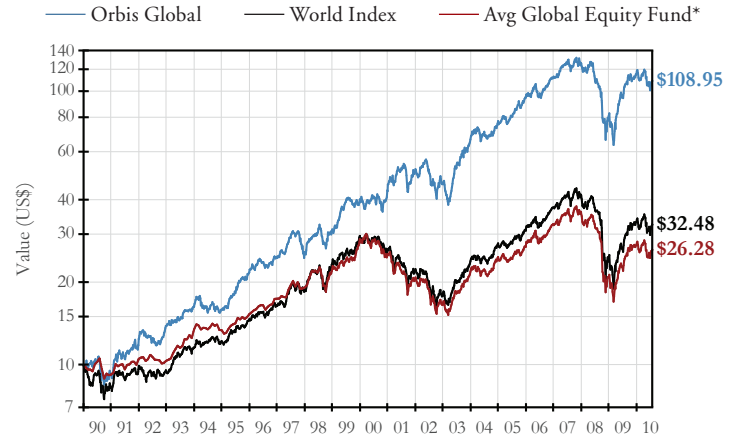
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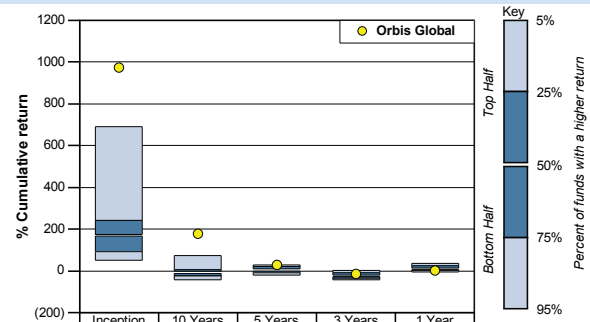
Value of \$10 invested at inception on 1 January 1990 (dividends reinvested)
