Commentary

After a very disappointing year in 2010, your Fund's relative performance improved significantly in the first month of the new year. Although we don't like to draw attention to short-term fluctuations, it is noteworthy that there have been no fundamental changes to the portfolio that would explain such an abrupt reversal. Turnover in holdings last year was very low by historical standards, and among the ten largest detractors from performance last year, we have maintained or increased our position in eight, eliminated one and reduced another. Does the recent outperformance mean that the market is coming around to our view – or is this just a short-term blip in a prolonged period of underperformance? We cannot be sure. Our investors can be certain, however, that we intend to stick to the disciplined investment process that has served the Fund well over more than two decades – and that we have a high degree of conviction in the Fund's current stock selections.

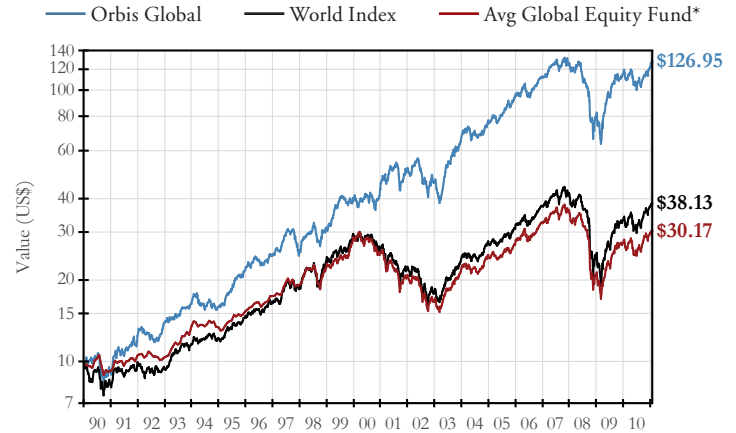

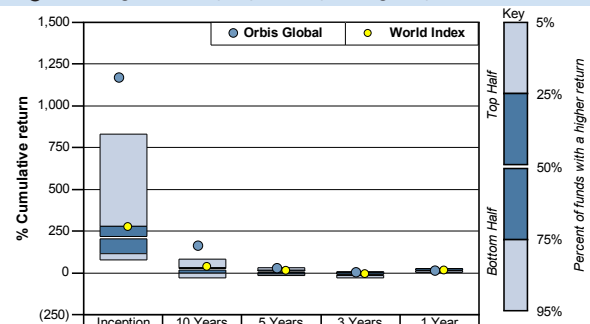
Value of \$10 invested at inception on 1 January 1990 (dividends reinvested)
