**Commentary**

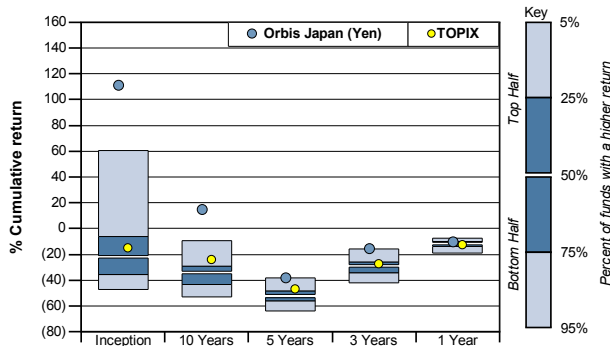
The sheer devastation of Japan's 11 March earthquake and tsunami was highly unusual, but earthquakes are quite common in Japan. So for companies that could be severely affected by earthquake damage, such as property and casualty insurers, we carefully assess this risk as part of our usual investment process. In the week following the earthquake, shares of property and casualty insurers NKSJ Holdings and MS&AD Insurance Group Holdings, two of your Fund's holdings, both fell more sharply than the broader Japanese stockmarket. Yet these firms bear surprisingly little risk from this type of event – they protect themselves by purchasing insurance from other non-Japanese insurers and the Japanese government. With NKSJ and MS&AD shares both trading at a substantial discount to our estimate of intrinsic value, we believe the stockmarket has overreacted, and that all of the bad news has been more than priced in.

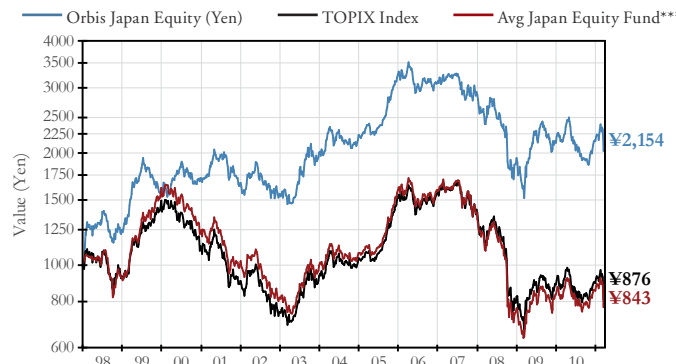

**Ranking within Japan equity fund peer group\*\***

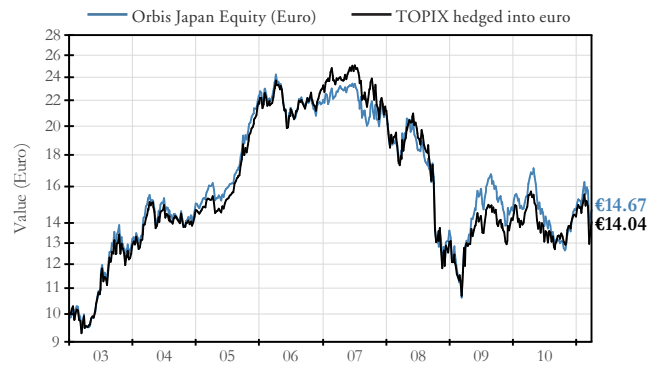
