



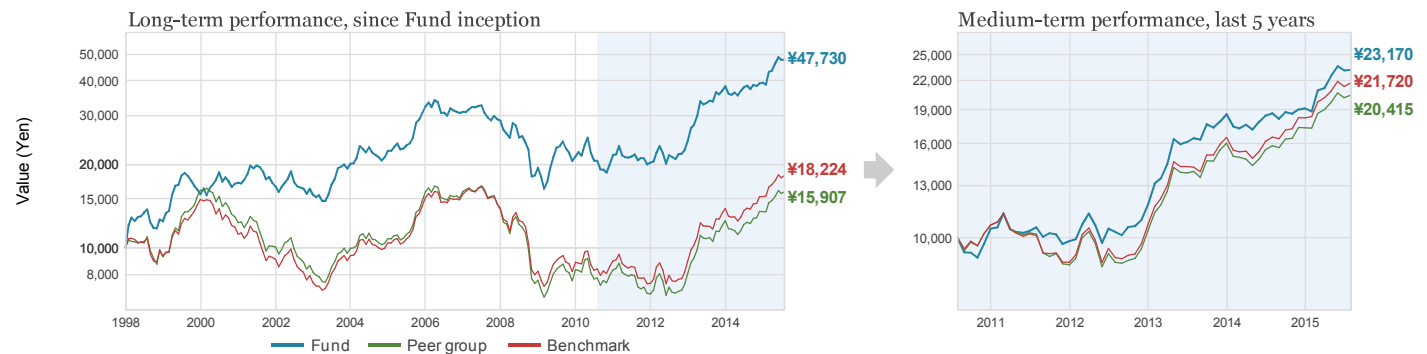
Orbis SICAV Japan Equity (Yen) Fund

Growth of ¥10,000 investment, dividends reinvested



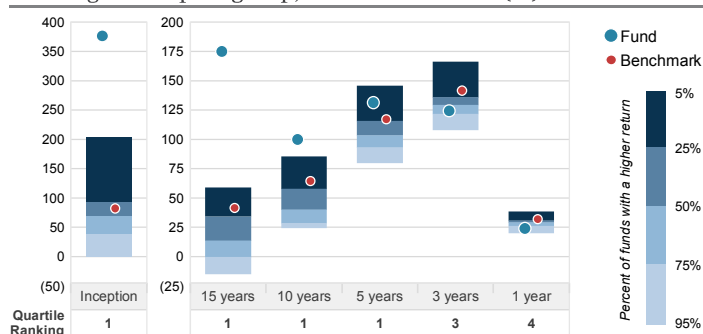
